## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Municipalities, Annexations, and Local Forms of
- 2 Government in DeKalb County; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, in Georgia, counties may be organized using the traditional commission, sole
- 4 commissioner, elected executive, commission-administrator, or commission-manager form
- 5 of government; and
- 6 WHEREAS, county governments in Georgia have anywhere from one to nine
- 7 commissioners; and
- 8 WHEREAS, there are currently 535 municipalities in the State of Georgia, with others being
- 9 contemplated to be created in the near future; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in Georgia, most municipalities have one of the following forms of government:
- 11 the strong mayor-council form, the weak mayor-council form, or the council-manager form;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, under both the strong and weak mayor-council forms, executive and
- 14 policy-making roles and responsibilities are divided between the mayor and the city council;
- under the council-manager form, the city council fills the primary policy-making role, and
- an appointed city manager is responsible for the primary executive functions; and
- 17 WHEREAS, over the past decade, numerous cities have been created through the annexation
- 18 process, including within DeKalb County; and
- 19 WHEREAS, due to the increased interest in establishing new municipalities in DeKalb
- 20 County and the different forms of government that exist in this county, it is important to
- 21 evaluate whether all current forms of government are necessary and effective and the impact
- annexations will have upon DeKalb County's government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that there is created the House Study Committee on Municipalities, Annexations, and Local Forms of Government in DeKalb County to be composed of five members of the DeKalb County delegation of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, one member appointed by the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners, one member appointed by the chief executive officer of DeKalb County, one member appointed by the DeKalb County Chamber of Commerce, and one member appointed by the DeKalb Municipal Association from its membership. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one of the members of the committee as chairperson. The committee shall meet at the call of the chairperson.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the above issues and recommend any actions or legislation that the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances authorized for legislative members of interim legislative committees but shall receive the same for not more than five days unless additional days are authorized. The funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from the funds appropriated to the House of Representatives. The committee shall publish a report of its findings and recommendations which may include suggestions for proposed legislation. Such report shall be made on or before December 31, 2013. The committee shall stand abolished on December 31, 2013.
