### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Oliver Morton Chapter of the Daughters of the American  
2 Revolution; and for other purposes.

4 organized on February 22, 2022, by Addie Kate Morton in her home city of Gray in Jones  
5 County, Georgia; and

11 assisting veteran patients, awarding student scholarships, and supporting DAR schools for
