## **A RESOLUTION**

- 1 Urging the Georgia Department of Transportation to study safety and accidents relating to
- 2 vehicle merging and to consider installing yield signs upon certain merging roadways; and
- 3 for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, safety for motorists traveling in Georgia is of the utmost importance to the
- 5 General Assembly; and
- 6 WHEREAS, according to Code Section 40-6-70 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 7 vehicles merging onto another roadway must yield the right of way to vehicles traveling upon
- 8 that road; and
- 9 WHEREAS, proper operation of a vehicle dictates that when the roadway you are traveling
- 10 on is merging into other traffic without stopping, the merging driver should adjust his or her
- speed and vehicle position to allow merging into the new lane safely; and
- 12 WHEREAS, placement of yield signs upon certain roads in this state that merge onto
- 13 highways with a speed limit of 45 miles per hour or more would provide clarity to confused
- 14 drivers on their responsibilities and could greatly reduce accidents; and

15 WHEREAS, study is needed by the department to determine whether adding yield signs to

- 16 certain roads that merge onto highways with a speed limit of 45 miles per hour or more is
- 17 warranted.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 19 the members of this body urge the Georgia Department of Transportation to study safety and
- 20 accidents relating to vehicle merging and to consider installing yield signs upon certain
- 21 merging roadways.
- 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 24 Georgia Department of Transportation.
