## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Peach Festival and the 2012 Georgia Peach Queens; and for other  
2 purposes.

4 Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, the Georgia peach industry has played a significant role in the economic growth  
6 and prosperity of our state, and Georgia ranks second in the nation in the annual production  
7 of peaches; and

16 Georgia Peach, Cassidy Starling; and Miss Georgia Peach, Anna Treadway; and

18 recognized by this body.
