- 1 Recognizing January 27, 2020, as International Holocaust Remembrance Day; and for other

- 10 million children, who were persecuted for their religious practices, political beliefs, sexual
- orientations, and physical disabilities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, we remember with admiration the resistors and saviors both known and
- 13 unknown who risked their lives to save others; and
- 14 WHEREAS, we remember with respect the survivors who escaped, were sheltered, or were
- 15 freed and who lived to contribute so much to our state, our country, and our world; and
- 16 WHEREAS, we pledge today to firmly commit ourselves to work to promote human dignity
- 17 by confronting intolerance and hate whenever and wherever it occurs.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 19 the members of this body recognize January 27, 2020, as International Holocaust
- 20 Remembrance Day in memory of the victims, survivors, rescuers, and liberators of the
- 21 Holocaust.
