16 culminating with the MCSD Teacher of the Year gala on May 2, 2013; and

17 WHEREAS, Kim Lester is a fifth grade teacher at Britt David Magnet Academy and a
18 semifinalist for 2013 Muscogee County School District Teacher of the Year; and

19 WHEREAS, the devotion to providing the students of Georgia with a quality education
20 demonstrated by Kim Lester is worthy of recognition.
