## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 45-9-81 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 definitions relative to the Georgia State Indemnification Fund, so as to provide for a short
- 3 title; to provide that delayed death from a condition which causes a total permanent disability
- 4 shall be deemed to have been in the line of duty; to provide for disabilities for firefighters
- 5 due to certain conditions contracted in the line of duty; to provide for a rebuttable
- 6 presumption; to provide for exceptions; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Stevenson-Gibson Act."

SECTION 2.

- 11 Code Section 45-9-81 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
- 12 relative to the Georgia State Indemnification Fund, is amended by revising subparagraph (C)
- of paragraph (6) as follows:

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- 14 "(C) With respect to a law enforcement officer or firefighter, while on duty and
- performing services for and receiving compensation from the law enforcement and fire
- service agency which employs such officer or firefighter, while off duty when
- 17 responding to any situation which would save a life or preserve the peace, or while
- preventing or attempting to prevent the commission of a crime or fire; provided,
- 19 <u>however, that a delayed death caused by a condition which resulted in a total permanent</u>
- 20 <u>disability as defined in paragraph (12) of this Code section shall be deemed to have</u>
- been in the line of duty. A law enforcement officer or firefighter who is performing

duties for and receiving compensation from a private employer at the time of such

- officer's or firefighter's death or bodily injury causing total permanent disability or
- partial permanent disability shall not be considered in the line of duty if the officer or

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25	firefighter is entitled to workers' compensation benefits from the private employer of
26	the private employer's insurer;"

SECTION 3.

- 28 Said Code section is further amended by revising paragraph (12) as follows:
- 29 "(12) 'Total permanent disability' means disability due to:
- 30 (A) Loss of both eyes or blindness in both eyes with only light perception;
- 31 (B) Loss or loss of use of both hands;
- 32 (C) Loss or loss of use of both legs;
- 33 (D) Loss of a lower extremity or the residual effect of an organic disease or injury
- which so affects the functions of balance or propulsion as to preclude locomotion
- without resort to a wheelchair at all times; or
- 36 (E) Organic brain damage; or
- 37 <u>(F) With respect to a firefighter who has been engaged either as a volunteer or as an</u>
- 38 employee by a governmental entity for an aggregate of at least five years, the inability
- 39 <u>to perform normal duties as a firefighter because of pulmonary injury, lung disease,</u>
- 40 <u>HIV/AIDS, meningitis, mesothelioma, or hepatitis.</u> For purposes of this paragraph,
- 41 <u>there shall be a rebuttable presumption that any of the enumerated conditions were</u>
- 42 contracted in the line of duty; provided, however, that if the disabled firefighter used
- 43 any tobacco product within five years of the onset of the disability or if the condition
- 44 <u>existed at the time he or she first became employed, there shall be no such rebuttable</u>
- 45 <u>presumption</u>."

46 SECTION 4.

47 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
