The House Committee on Judiciary Non-civil offers the following substitute to SB 187:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 50-36-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 requirements, procedures, and conditions for verification of lawful presence within the
- 3 United States, so as to provide exemptions for the board of commissioners of the Georgia
- 4 Student Finance Commission and the board of directors of the Georgia Student Finance
- 5 Authority; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 50-36-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to requirements,
- 9 procedures, and conditions for verification of lawful presence within the United States, is
- amended by revising paragraph (7) of subsection (d) as follows:
- 11 "(7) For postsecondary education, whereby the Board of Regents of the University
- 12 System of Georgia, or the State Board of the Technical College System of Georgia, the
- board of commissioners of the Georgia Student Finance Commission, and the board of
- directors of the Georgia Student Finance Authority shall set forth, or cause to be set forth,
- policies <u>or regulations</u>, <u>or both</u>, regarding postsecondary benefits that comply with all
- federal law including but not limited to public benefits as described in 8 U.S.C.
- 17 Section 1611, 1621, or 1623. <u>The Georgia Student Finance Commission and the Georgia</u>
- 18 <u>Student Finance Authority shall not require the submission of the federal Free</u>
- 19 Application for Federal Student Aid or federal or state income tax returns as a part of an
- 20 <u>application for a HOPE scholarship."</u>
- SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
