**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend Code Section 31-8-51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 definitions relative to the long-term care ombudsman program, so as to change a definition;
3 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 31-8-51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
7 relative to the long-term care ombudsman program, is amended by revising paragraph (2) as
8 follows:

9 "(2) 'Long-term care facility' means any skilled nursing home, intermediate care home,
10 private home care provider, assisted living community, or personal care home now or
11 hereafter subject to regulation and licensure by the Department of Community Health."

12 **SECTION 2.**

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
