## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To repeal an Act creating a public body corporate and politic, and an instrumentality of the
- 2 County of Sumter, to be known as the Sumter County Livestock Authority, approved April 7,
- 3 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5757), as amended by an Act approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001,
- 4 p. 4175); to provide for the assets and liabilities thereof; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 provide a specific repealer; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 6 other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 An Act creating a public body corporate and politic, and an instrumentality of the County of
- 10 Sumter, to be known as the Sumter County Livestock Authority, approved April 7, 1992 (Ga.
- 11 L. 1992, p. 5757), as amended by an Act approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4175), is
- 12 hereby repealed in its entirety.

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 There are no known assets of the Sumter County Livestock Authority, but to the extent any
- 15 assets of the Sumter County Livestock Authority exist, they shall devolve to Sumter County
- 16 automatically and without further action. The governing body of Sumter County is
- 17 authorized to execute any deeds or instruments of conveyance required to place title of such
- 18 assets into the name of Sumter County and is authorized to do so in the name of the Sumter
- 19 County Livestock Authority. There are no known obligations of the Sumter County
- 20 Livestock Authority, but to the extent such obligations exist, they shall be transferred to and
- 21 assumed by Sumter County by such instruments as may be required to maintain the same.
- 22 The governing body of Sumter County is authorized to execute any such instruments
- 23 required to transfer such obligations into the name of Sumter County and is authorized to do
- so in the name of the Sumter County Livestock Authority.
