17 (B) The the private property of another without the written permission of the owner or

- occupier of the such private property to do so;
- 19 (3) Intends to conceal his or her identity; and
- 20 (4) With reasonable foresight that injury would probably result:
- 21 (A) Intends to threaten, intimidate, or provoke the apprehension of violence;
- 22 (B) Acts with reckless disregard for the consequences of his or her conduct; or
- 23 (C) Acts with a heedless indifference to the rights and safety of others.
- 24 (b) This Code section shall not apply to Without limiting the generality of subsection (a)
- of this Code section, no person shall be guilty of violating this Code section by:
- 26 (1) A person wearing Wearing a traditional holiday costume on the occasion of the
