A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 mandatory education for children between the ages of six and 16, so as to lower the starting
- 3 age for compulsory education attendance from six years to five years of age; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-2-690.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to mandatory
- 8 education for children between the ages of six and 16, is amended by revising subsection (a)
- 9 as follows:
- 10 "(a) Mandatory attendance in a public school, private school, or home school program shall
- be required for children between their sixth fifth and sixteenth birthdays. Such mandatory
- 12 attendance shall not be required where the child has successfully completed all
- 13 requirements for a high school diploma."

14 SECTION 2.

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
