A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act fixing the compensation of the board of commissioners of counties having
2 a population in excess of 500,000, according to the 1970 United States Census, or any future
3 census, and providing that the commissioners shall be authorized to fix the compensation of
4 the chairman and commissioners within certain limitations, approved March 30, 1971
5 (Ga. L. 1971, p. 2369), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 17, 2002
6 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 1473); to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act fixing the compensation of the board of commissioners of counties having a
10 population in excess of 500,000, according to the 1970 United States Census, or any future
11 census, and providing that the commissioners shall be authorized to fix the compensation of
12 the chairman and commissioners within certain limitations, approved March 30, 1971
13 (Ga. L. 1971, p. 2369), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 17, 2002
14 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 1473), is repealed in its entirety.
