A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To create a board of elections and registration for Chatham County; to provide for its powers 2 and duties; to provide for definitions; to provide for the composition of the board and the 3 selection, election, and appointment of members; to provide for the qualifications, terms, and 4 removal of members; to provide for vacancies; to provide for oaths and privileges; to provide 5 for the conduct of primaries and elections; to provide for meetings; to provide for an executive director to serve as the election supervisor; to authorize the conduct of municipal 6 7 elections; to allow for joint primaries; to authorize expenditure of public funds; to provide 8 compensation for board members and staff; to provide for offices, supplies, and other 9 materials; to provide for the transfer of powers, duties, facilities, and personal property; to 10 provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal a specific Act; to repeal 11 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

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- 14 Pursuant to subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 15 Annotated, there is created the Board of Elections and Registration of Chatham County. The
- 16 Board of Elections and Registration of Chatham County shall have the powers, duties, and

17 responsibilities of the superintendent of elections of Chatham County under Chapter 2 of

- 18 Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code," as the same
- 19 now exists or may hereafter be amended, which powers, duties, and responsibilities are
- 20 currently being exercised by the Board of Elections of Chatham County, and the powers,
- 21 duties, and responsibilities of the Board of Registrars of Chatham County under Chapter 2
- 22 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code," as the
- 23 same now exists or may hereafter be amended.
- SECTION 2.
- 25 As used in this Act, the term:
- 26 (1) "Board" means the Chatham County Board of Elections and Registration.
- 27 (2) "Commissioners" means the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County.
- 28 (3) "County" means Chatham County.
- 29 (4) "Election," "elector," "primary," and "public office" shall have the same meanings
- as ascribed to those terms by Code Section 21-2-2 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated, unless otherwise clearly apparent from the text of this Act.
- 32 SECTION 3.
- 33 (a) The board shall be composed of five members, each of whom shall be an elector and
- resident of the county and who shall be appointed as provided in this section.
- 35 (b) Except for the initial board members as provided for in subsection (f) of this section,
- four members of the board shall be elected as follows:
- 37 (1) Two members shall be elected by the political party whose candidate for the office
- of Governor at the last election for such office received the highest number of votes cast
- for such office within the county; and

40 (2) Two members shall be elected by the political party whose candidate for the office 41 of Governor at the last election for such office received the second highest number of 42 votes cast for such office within the county. 43 (c) The winners of each election provided for in subsection (b) of this section, and runoff 44 if necessary, shall take office as members of the board on January 1, 2023, for terms of four 45 years and until their successors are elected and qualified. Such winners shall be certified 46 by the board in office at the time of the primaries to the clerk of the superior court of 47 Chatham County and to the Secretary of State. Such winners, upon taking office, shall take 48 an oath substantially the same as the oath required by law for county registrars to take 49 office. 50 (d) Thereafter, pursuant to the same procedures and requirements set forth in this section, 51 successors shall be elected at the general primary, and runoff if necessary, immediately 52 preceding the expiration of the then current terms of office and shall take office on the first 53 day of January immediately following their election for terms of four years and until their 54 successors are elected and qualified. 55 (e)(1) The fifth member of the board shall be the chairperson of the board. Except as 56 provided for in subsection (f) of this section, the chairperson shall be appointed by the 57 Board of Commissioners of Chatham County within 30 days of the beginning of a

provided for in subsection (f) of this section, the chairperson shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County within 30 days of the beginning of a four-year term. The term of office of the chairperson shall coincide with the terms of office of the elected members of the board.

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(2) If, at the end of the 30 day period provided for in paragraph (1) of this subsection, such county commissioners have not been able to agree upon the appointment of a chairperson, the chairperson of the board shall be appointed by a committee composed of the senior superior court judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit, the Chairperson of the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County, the judges of the State Court of Chatham County, the foreman of the Grand Jury of Chatham County, and the chairperson of the Grand Jury Conference Committee of Chatham County.

67 (f)(1) Four of the initial members of the board provided for by this Act shall be the four

- 68 elected members of the Board of Elections of Chatham County serving on June 30, 2021.
- The fifth initial member shall be the chairperson of the Board of Registrars serving on
- 70 June 30, 2021.

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- 71 (2) The initial members as outlined in this subsection shall serve until
- December 31, 2022, and their successors having been duly elected, or in the case of the
- chairperson appointed, and given the oath required by law for county registrars to take
- office on January 1, 2023.
- 75 (3) The term of each initial member shall commence on July 1, 2021.

76 SECTION 4.

77 No person who holds elective or appointive office, or is a salaried employee of the governing 78 authority of Chatham County or of a municipality located within said county, or any member 79 of the Board of Education of Chatham County, or any member of any commission appointed 80 by the governing authority or any municipality located within Chatham County, shall be eligible for appointment or election to the board if the person has so served within three 81 82 months immediately preceding the person's becoming a member of the board in the case of 83 the chairperson or within three months immediately preceding the person's qualifying to run 84 for any elected position on the board; provided, however, that any member of the board shall 85 be eligible for reelection to the board.

SECTION 5.

Each member of the board shall be eligible to serve successive terms, shall have the right to resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the board, to the clerk of the superior court, and to the Secretary of State. Each member of the board shall be subject to removal from office for misfeasance or malfeasance in office on the grounds of and in the

91 manner prescribed for the removal of clerks of the superior court as provided in Code 92 Section 15-6-82 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

SECTION 6.

In the event any vacancy shall occur for any reason, the party which elected the member in which the vacancy shall occur shall nominate a qualified person to be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County to fill the vacancy for the unexpired term. In the event any vacancy shall occur for any reason in the office of chairperson, the remaining members of the board shall appoint a chairperson within 30 days following the occurrence of the vacancy. If, at the end of such 30 day period, such members have not been able to agree upon the appointment of a chairperson, the chairperson shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County when the other members of the board fail to act.

SECTION 7.

Before entering upon his or her duties, a member of the board shall take substantially the same oath as required by law for registrars and shall have the same privileges from arrest.

SECTION 8.

(a) The board shall be authorized to organize itself, determine its procedural rules and regulations, adopt bylaws, specify policies for the functions and duties of its employees and poll workers, and otherwise take such action as is appropriate to the management of the affairs committed to its supervision; provided, however, that no such action shall conflict with state law. Action and decision by the board shall be by a majority of the members of the board.

(b)(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the board shall be responsible for the selection and appointment of an executive director, to be known as the election supervisor, to administer and supervise conduct of elections, primaries, and

registration of electors for the county. The election supervisor may be terminated with cause by the board and shall not be governed under the authority of the board of commissioners or any of their agents. The election supervisor shall have the authority, within the policies established by the board, over retention, termination, and discipline of employees, as well as training of poll workers in primaries and elections, such poll workers to be appointed by the election supervisor.

(2) The Board of Commissioners of Chatham County shall appoint an initial permanent executive director under this Act. The executive director shall serve immediately following said appointment.

(c) The board shall be empowered with all the powers and duties relating to the conduct of primaries and elections as election superintendent pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code." The board shall be empowered with all the powers and duties relating to the registration of voters and absentee balloting procedures as boards of registrars pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code." This Act is intended to implement the provisions of subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and shall be construed liberally so as to effectuate that purpose. The board shall be authorized and empowered to organize itself, determine its procedural rules and regulations, adopt bylaws, specify the functions and duties of its employees, and otherwise take such action as is appropriate to the management of its affairs; provided, however, that no such action shall conflict with state law. Action and decision by the board shall be by a majority of the members of the board.

SECTION 9.

The election supervisor shall be authorized to employ such full-time and part-time employees, including poll workers, as may be deemed necessary by the election supervisor

and as approved in the annual budget adopted by the Board of Commissioners of ChathamCounty.

SECTION 10.

143 Compensation for the members of the board, clerical assistants, and other employees shall 144 be fixed by the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County. Such compensation shall be 145 paid wholly from county funds.

SECTION 11.

The board shall have the authority to conduct municipal elections and primaries for any municipality located within the county if such municipality has entered into a contract for that purpose with the commissioners and in conformance with Code Section 21-2-45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

SECTION 12.

The chairperson of the board shall conduct all meetings of the board and shall possess a reserved vote in the event of a tie amongst the four elected board members. The board shall fix and establish, by appropriate resolution or motion entered on its minutes, directives governing the execution of matters within its jurisdiction. The board shall have regular meetings and shall meet not fewer than four times per year. Any special called meeting shall be called by the chairperson or any two members of the board. All meetings of whatever kind of the board shall be conducted pursuant to Chapter 14 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to open meetings. The board shall maintain a written record of policy decisions that shall be amended to include additions or deletions. Such written records shall be subject to Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to inspection of public records.

163 **SECTION 13.** 164 The Board of Commissioners of Chatham County shall provide the board with such proper and suitable offices, equipment, materials, and supplies and with such clerical assistance and 165 other employees as the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County shall deem appropriate. 166 167 **SECTION 14.** 168 Nothing in this Act shall be construed to require or prohibit joint primaries or to require or 169 prohibit the commissioners or any other public agency to bear any expense of conducting 170 primaries not otherwise required by law. 171 **SECTION 15.** 172 The board shall be authorized to expend public funds for the purpose of preparing and 173 distributing material solely to inform and instruct electors of the county adequately with 174 regard to elections. No material distributed by the board shall contain or express, in any manner or form, any commentary or expression of opinion or request for support with respect 175 176 to any political issue or matter of political concern. 177 **SECTION 16.** 178 Upon the effective date of this Act, the Board of Elections of Chatham County and the Board 179 of Registrars of Chatham County shall be relieved of all powers and duties transferred to the 180 board by this Act and shall deliver to the board all facilities and personal property, including 181 but not limited to equipment, supplies, materials, books, papers, and records pertaining to

184 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021.

such powers and duties.

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185 **SECTION 18.**

186 An Act creating the Board of Elections of Chatham County, approved March 29, 1984

187 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 5197), and all amendatory Acts are hereby repealed in their entirety.

188 **SECTION 19.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
