The Senate Committee on Judiciary offered the following substitute to SB 31:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to general provisions relative to prosecuting attorneys, so as to provide for the 3 reimbursement of expenses incurred by the Attorney General in prosecuting a criminal case 4 or cases due to the failure of a district attorney to prosecute such criminal case or cases; to 5 provide for motions and hearings regarding such expenses; to provide for related matters; to 6 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 Article 1 of Chapter 18 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
10 general provisions relative to prosecuting attorneys, is amended by adding a new Code
11 section to read as follows:

12 <u>"15-18-12.1.</u>

(a) When the Attorney General prosecutes a criminal case or cases due to a district
 attorney's refusal to do so and obtains a guilty plea or pleas or guilty verdict or verdicts, the

15 Department of Law may request reimbursement of actual travel expenses incurred and the

16 <u>actual cost of the time spent by the Attorney General and any assistant in the prosecution</u>

17 of such criminal case or cases from those funds made available to the district attorney's

- 18 office that failed to prosecute such criminal case or cases. Such requests shall be made by
- 19 motion filed with the judge before whom the prosecution occurred within 15 days of the
- 20 plea or verdict.
- 21 (b) Within 15 days of the filing of a motion pursuant to subsection (a) of this Code section,
- 22 the judge shall hold a hearing to determine whether the district attorney failed to perform
- 23 his or her official duties, and upon such a finding shall hear evidence as to the expenses and
- 24 costs incurred by the Department of Law and award all reasonable expenses and costs to
- 25 the Department of Law."

SECTION 2.

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
