## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 8 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to county
- 2 police, so as to provide a method for the abolition of a county police department and
- 3 returning the law enforcement functions of such department to the sheriff of the county; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 8 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to county police,
- 8 is amended by revising Code Section 36-8-6, which was previously reserved, as follows:
- 9 "36-8-6.
- 10 (a) After a county police department is created pursuant to this chapter, it may be
- 11 <u>abolished by:</u>
- 12 (1) A local Act of the General Assembly; or
- 13 (2) A resolution of the governing authority of the county.
- 14 (b) A local Act or resolution of the county governing authority to abolish a county police
- department pursuant to subsection (a) of this Code section shall be conditioned upon
- approval of such local Act or resolution of the county governing authority by the electors
- of the county voting in a referendum.
- 18 (c) If such local Act or resolution of the county governing authority is approved by the
- 19 <u>electors of the county, the county police department shall be abolished 180 days following</u>
- 20 <u>such referendum</u>. At such time, all property, equipment, records, documents, funds, and
- 21 other items in the possession or control of the county police department shall be transferred
- 22 <u>to the sheriff of the county</u> Reserved."

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
