A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 physicians, assistants, and others, so as to authorize physicians to delegate to advanced
- 3 practice registered nurses and physician assistants the authority to dispense prepackaged
- 4 medications other than controlled substances as an agent or employee of a clinic; to provide
- 5 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to physicians,
- 9 assistants, and others, is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 43-34-25,
- 10 relating to delegation of certain medical acts to advanced practice registered nurse,
- 11 construction and limitations of such delegation, definitions, conditions of nurse protocol, and
- 12 issuance of prescription drug orders, to read as follows:
- 13 "(e.2) An advanced practice registered nurse may be authorized under a nurse protocol
- 14 agreement to dispense prepackaged medications, other than controlled substances, if such
- 15 advanced practice registered nurse dispenses such medications as an agent or employee of
- 16 <u>a clinic.</u>"

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 43-34-103,
- 19 relating to delegation of authority to physician assistants, to read as follows:
- 20 "(e.3) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this Code section, a physician assistant may be
- 21 <u>authorized under a job description to dispense prepackaged medications, other than</u>
- 22 controlled substances, if such physician assistant dispenses such medications as an agent
- 23 or employee of a clinic."
- SECTION 3.
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
