A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-7-21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 criminal trespass, so as to provide for increased punishment applicable to criminal trespass
- 3 upon certain military graves; to provide for the new crime of criminal trespass upon
- 4 nonmilitary graves; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-7-21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to criminal
- 9 trespass, is amended by revising subsections (d) and (e) and adding a new subsection to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 "(d) Except as provided in subsection (e) of this Code section, a person convicted A person
- who commits the offense of criminal trespass shall be guilty of punished as for a
- misdemeanor.
- 14 (e) A person commits the offense of criminal trespass when he or she intentionally
- defaces, mutilates, or defiles any grave marker, monument, or memorial to recognizing one
- or more deceased persons who served in the military service of this state, the United States
- of America or any of the states thereof, or the Confederate States of America or any of the
- states thereof, or a monument, plaque, marker, or memorial which is dedicated to, honors,
- or recounts the military service of any past or present military personnel of this state, the
- 20 United States of America or any of the states thereof, or the Confederate States of America
- or any of the states thereof if such grave marker, monument, memorial, plaque, or marker
- is privately owned or located on land which is privately owned. A person convicted of
- 23 <u>criminal trespass in violation of this subsection shall be punished as for a misdemeanor of</u>
- 24 <u>a high and aggravated nature.</u>
- 25 (f) A person commits the offense of criminal trespass when he or she intentionally defaces,
- 26 <u>mutilates, or defiles any grave marker, monument, or memorial recognizing one or more</u>

27 <u>deceased persons if such grave marker, monument, or memorial is privately owned or</u>

28 located on land which is privately owned."

SECTION 2.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
