A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-2-295 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 military student transfers, so as to provide military students with the discretion to select
- 3 adjacent school districts for attendance; to provide for a standard process of military student
- 4 school transfers; to provide for annual notification; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 20-2-295 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to military
- 9 student transfers, is amended by adding new subsections to read as follows:
- 10 "(d) Military students shall be allowed to attend any public school of their parent's or legal
- guardian's choosing, regardless of the residence of the child, provided that the school is in
- 12 the school district where the student resides or is located within 50 miles of where such
- 13 <u>student resides and space is available for additional enrollment. The parent shall assume</u>
- the responsibility for and cost of transportation of the student to and from the school.
- 15 (e) Each local school system located within 50 miles shall:

- (1) Establish a universal, streamlined process available to all students to implement the
 transfer requirements; and
 (2) Annually notify, prior to each school year, the parents of each military student by
 letter, by electronic means, or by such other reasonable means in a timely manner of the
 options available to the parent under this Code section."

- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
