BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 8 9 medical practice relative to physicians, assistants, and others, is amended by adding a new 10 Code section to read as follows: "43-34-22.1. 11 (a) No physician shall advertise or hold himself or herself out to the public in any manner 12 as being certified or board certified in any specialty or subspecialty by a public or private 13 14 board, including, but not limited to, a multidisciplinary board, unless: 15 (1) The advertisement or publication states the full name of the certifying board; and 16 (2) Such certifying board either: 17 (A) Is a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties, the American Board of Physician Specialties, or the American Osteopathic Association; or 18 19 (B) Requires successful completion of a postgraduate training program approved by 20 the Accreditation Commission for Graduate Medical Education or the American 21 Osteopathic Association that provides complete training in the specialty or subspecialty 22 certified, followed by prerequisite certification by the American Board of Medical 23 Specialties, the American Board of Physician Specialties, or the American Osteopathic 24 Association board for that training field, and further successful completion of an 25 examination in the specialty or subspecialty certified.
