A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 23 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 "Georgia Hemp Farming Act," so as to allow persons convicted of any misdemeanor or
- 3 certain felonies to grow industrial hemp; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Chapter 23 of Title 2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the "Georgia
- 7 Hemp Farming Act," is amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (c) of
- 8 Code Section 2-23-5, relating to limitations for hemp licensing, as follows:
- 9 "(3) No license shall be issued to any applicant who has been convicted of a
- 10 misdemeanor involving sale of or trafficking in a controlled substance or a felony related
- 11 <u>to a state or federally controlled substance within ten years of the date of application</u> or
- who materially falsifies any information contained in a license application."

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 Said chapter is further amended by revising paragraph (3) of subsection (c) of
- 15 Code Section 2-23-6, relating to limitations for hemp permitting, as follows:

"(3) No permit shall be issued to any applicant who has been convicted of a misdemeanor involving sale of or trafficking in a controlled substance or a felony related to a state or federally controlled substance within ten years of the date of application or who materially falsifies any information contained in a license application."

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
