## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-5-24 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 instruction permits, graduated licensing and related restrictions, and temporary licenses
- 3 relative to the operation of a motor vehicle, so as to revise restrictions upon the operation of
- 4 Class C motor vehicles by Class D license holders with certain passengers in the vehicle; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 40-5-24 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to instruction
- 9 permits, graduated licensing and related restrictions, and temporary licenses relative to the
- 10 operation of a motor vehicle, is amended by revising paragraph (2) of subsection (b) as
- 11 follows:

- 12 "(2) The department shall, after all applicable requirements have been met, issue to the
- applicant a Class D driver's license which shall entitle the applicant, while having such
- license in his or her immediate possession, to drive a Class C vehicle upon the public
- highways of this state under the following conditions:

16 (A) Any Class D license holder shall not drive a Class C motor vehicle on the public 17 roads, streets, or highways of this state between the hours of 12:00 Midnight and 18 5:00 A.M. eastern standard time or eastern daylight time, whichever is applicable; and 19 (B)(i) Except as otherwise provided in division (ii) of this subparagraph, any Any 20 Class D license holder shall not drive a Class C motor vehicle upon the public roads, 21 streets, or highways of this state when more than three other passengers in the vehicle 22 who are not members of the driver's immediate family are less than 21 years of age. 23 (ii) During the six-month twelve-month period immediately following issuance of 24 such license, any Class D license holder shall not drive a Class C motor vehicle upon 25 the public roads, streets, or highways of this state when any more than one other passenger in the vehicle who is not a member of the driver's immediate family. 26 (iii) Notwithstanding the provisions of division (i) of this subparagraph, during the 27 28 second six-month period immediately following issuance of such license, any Class 29 D license holder shall not drive a Class C motor vehicle upon the public roads, streets, 30 or highways of this state when more than one other passenger in the vehicle who is 31 not a member of the driver's immediate family is less than 21 years of age; 32 provided, however, that a Class D license holder shall not be charged with a violation of 33 this paragraph alone but may be charged with violating this paragraph in addition to any 34 other traffic offense.; and 35 (C) For purposes of this paragraph, the term 'immediate family' shall include the 36 license holder's parents and stepparents, grandparents, siblings and stepsiblings, 37 children, and any other person who resides at the license holder's residence."
