A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 17-6-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when
- 2 offenses bailable, procedure, schedule of bails, and appeal bonds, so as to add the offense of
- 3 human trafficking as a bailable offense; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Code Section 17-6-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when offenses
- 8 bailable, procedure, schedule of bails, and appeal bonds, is amended by revising subsection
- 9 (a) as follows:

- 10 "(a) The following offenses are bailable only before a judge of the superior court:
- 11 (1) Treason;
- 12 (2) Murder;
- 13 (3) Rape;
- 14 (4) Aggravated sodomy;
- 15 (5) Armed robbery;
- 16 (5.1) Home invasion in the first degree;

- 17 (6) Aircraft hijacking and hijacking a motor vehicle in the first degree;
- 18 (7) Aggravated child molestation;
- 19 (8) Aggravated sexual battery;
- 20 (9) Manufacturing, distributing, delivering, dispensing, administering, or selling any
- 21 controlled substance classified under Code Section 16-13-25 as Schedule I or under Code
- Section 16-13-26 as Schedule II;
- 23 (10) Violating Code Section 16-13-31 or Code Section 16-13-31.1;
- 24 (11) Kidnapping, arson, aggravated assault, or burglary in any degree if the person, at
- 25 the time of the alleged kidnapping, arson, aggravated assault, or burglary in any degree,
- had previously been convicted of, was on probation or parole with respect to, or was on
- bail for kidnapping, arson, aggravated assault, burglary in any degree, or one or more of
- the offenses listed in paragraphs (1) through (10) of this subsection;
- 29 (12) Aggravated stalking; and
- 30 (13) Violating Code Section 16-5-46; and
- 31 (14) Violations of Chapter 15 of Title 16."
- 32 SECTION 2.
- 33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
