The Senate Committee on the Judiciary offered the following substitute to SB 493:

# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the sexual offender risk review board, so as to provide for additional penalties for
- 3 registered sexual offenders convicted of photographing a minor without the consent of the
- 4 minor's parent or guardian; to provide that such persons are prohibited from possessing,
- 5 owning, or operating an unmanned aircraft system with the intent to photograph, observe,
- 6 follow, or contact any person without his or her consent; to provide for criminal penalties;
- 7 to provide for definitions; to amend Chapter 8 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 8 Annotated, relating to probation, so as to provide for a possible term of probation; to provide
- 9 for an effective date; to provide for applicability; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 10 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- SECTION 1.
- 13 Article 2 of Chapter 1 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 14 sexual offender risk review board, is amended by revising Code Section 42-1-18, relating to
- 15 photographing minor without consent of parent or guardian prohibited and penalty, as
- 16 follows:

- 17 "42-1-18.
- 18 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Minor' shall have the same meaning as set forth in Code Section 42-1-12.
- 20 (2) 'Photograph' means to create, capture, transmit, or record by electronic or other
- 21 means a photographic image 'photograph' means to take any picture, film or digital
- 22 photograph, motion picture film, videotape, or similar visual representation or image of
- 23 a person.
- 24 (3) 'Unmanned aircraft system' means a powered, aerial vehicle, not including a satellite,
- 25 <u>that:</u>
- 26 (A) Does not carry a human operator and is operated without the possibility of direct
- 27 <u>human intervention from within or on the vehicle;</u>
- 28 (B) Uses aerodynamic forces to provide vehicle lift;
- 29 (C) Can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely;
- 30 (D) Can be expendable or recoverable; and
- 31 (E) Has the ability to photograph.
- 32 (b)(1) No person required to register as a sexual offender pursuant to Code Section
- 33 42-1-12 shall intentionally photograph a minor without the consent of the minor's parent
- or guardian.
- 35 (c)(2) Any person who knowingly violates this Code section commits the offense of
- 36 intentionally photographing a minor without the consent of such minor's parent or
- 37 guardian in violation of paragraph (1) of this subsection shall, upon the first conviction
- 38 <u>thereof</u>, be guilty of a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature <u>and shall be punished</u>
- as provided by Code Section 17-10-4; provided, however, that, if a fine is imposed
- 40 pursuant to Code Section 17-10-4, such fine shall not be less than \$1,500.00.
- 41 (3) Any person who commits the offense of intentionally photographing a minor without
- 42 the consent of such minor's parent or guardian in violation of paragraph (1) of this
- 43 <u>subsection shall, upon a second or subsequent conviction thereof, be guilty of a felony</u>

and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than 30 years and

- 45 <u>a fine of not less than \$5,000.00 nor more than \$100,000.00.</u>
- 46 (4) For the purpose of this subsection, the term 'conviction' shall include a plea of nolo
- 47 <u>contendere.</u>
- 48 (c)(1) No person required to register as a sexual offender pursuant to Code
- 49 <u>Section 42-1-12 shall knowingly possess, own, or operate an unmanned aircraft system</u>
- with the intent to photograph, observe, follow, or contact any person without his or her
- 51 <u>consent.</u>
- 52 (2) Any person who commits the offense of knowingly possessing, owning, or operating
- an unmanned aircraft system with the intent to photograph, observe, follow, or contact
- any person without his or her consent in violation of paragraph (1) of this subsection shall
- be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than ten nor
- more than 30 years and a fine of not less than \$20,000.00 nor more than \$100,000.00."

#### SECTION 2.

- 58 Chapter 8 of Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to probation, is
- 59 amended in subsection (b) of Code Section 42-8-35, relating to terms and conditions of
- 60 probation and supervision, by striking "and" at the end of paragraph (3), replacing the period
- 61 with "; and" at the end of paragraph (4), and adding a new paragraph to read as follows:
- 62 "(5) Prohibited from possessing, owning, or operating an unmanned aircraft system as
- defined in Code Section 42-1-18."

### SECTION 3.

- 65 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024, and shall apply to all offenses committed
- 66 on or after such date.

## 67 **SECTION 4.**

68 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
