A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public utilities and
- 2 public transportation, so as to prohibit governmental entities from adopting any policy that
- 3 prohibits the connection or reconnection of any utility service based upon the type or source
- 4 of energy or fuel; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Title 46 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to public utilities and public
- 9 transportation, is amended by adding a new Code section to read follows:
- 10 "46-1-6.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 12 <u>(1) 'Governmental entity' means any:</u>
- 13 (A) Municipality, public corporation, political subdivision, instrumentality, body
- politic, authority, district, consolidated government, county, or any board, commission,
- agency, department, or board of any such entity;
- 16 (B) State board, commission, agency, department, or board; or
- 17 (C) Other form of government.
- 18 (2) 'Policy' means an ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, or any other requirement
- imposed by a governmental entity.
- 20 (b) No governmental entity of this state shall adopt any policy that prohibits, or has the
- 21 <u>effect of prohibiting, the connection or reconnection of any utility service based upon the</u>
- 22 type or source of energy or fuel to be delivered to any customer.
- 23 (c) Nothing in this Code section shall limit the ability of a governmental entity to choose
- 24 <u>utility services for properties owned by such governmental entity."</u>

25 SECTION 2.

- 26 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 27 without such approval.

28 SECTION 3.

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
