**AS PASSED SENATE**

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend Part 2 of Article 15 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, the "Fair Business Practices Act of 1975," so as provide that the failure of a  
3 marketplace innkeeper to provide a consumer with an itemized receipt detailing certain taxes  
4 and fees is an unlawful business practice; to provide for a definition; to provide for related  
5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 2 of Article 15 of Chapter 1 of Title 10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the  
9 "Fair Business Practices Act of 1975," is amended in subsection (b) of Code Section  
10 10-1-393, relating to unfair or deceptive practices in consumer transactions unlawful and  
11 examples, by striking "and" at the end of paragraph (34), striking the period at the end of  
12 paragraph (35) and inserting"; and" in lieu thereof, and by adding a new paragraph to read  
13 as follows:

14 "(36)(A) Failure of a marketplace innkeeper to provide a consumer with an itemized  
15 receipt detailing the amount and type of each tax and fee charged to the consumer in  
16 relation to the rental or lease of any room, lodging, or accommodation.

17 (B) As used in this paragraph, the term 'marketplace innkeeper' has the same meaning  
18 as provided in paragraph (2.1) of Code Section 48-13-50.2."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 This act shall become law on January 1, 2025.
