A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-10-14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 issuance of a new birth certificate following adoption and legitimation or paternity
- 3 determination, so as to provide for the issuance of a copy of the original birth certificate to
- 4 certain adult persons who were adopted; to provide for a fee; to provide for the form of such
- 5 copy; to standardize terminology relating to birth certificates; to provide for related matters;
- 6 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 31-10-14 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to issuance of a
- 10 new birth certificate following adoption and legitimation or paternity determination, is
- amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 12 "(h)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code section or any other provision
- of law, any person who is 18 years of age or older who was born in this state and for
- whom a new birth certificate was established pursuant to paragraph (1) of subsection (a)
- of this Code section may request and receive a copy of his or her original birth certificate
- by complying with the provisions of this subsection. The state registrar shall require a
- person seeking an original birth certificate to pay the fee for a birth certificate as

prescribed pursuant to Code Section 31-10-27. The copy of the original birth certificate

- shall be in a form that clearly indicates it is not a certified copy and that it may not be
- 20 <u>used for legal purposes.</u>
- 21 (2) If the person who was born in this state and for whom a new birth certificate was
- 22 established pursuant to paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of this Code section is deceased,
- 23 any parent, sibling, or descendant of that person may receive a copy of the decedent's
- 24 <u>original birth certificate pursuant to the procedures contained in this subsection.</u>
- 25 (3) This subsection shall apply to all applications for original birth certificates for
- 26 <u>adopted persons presented to the state registrar on or after July 1, 2023."</u>
- SECTION 2.
- 28 The Official Code of Georgia Annotated is amended by replacing "certificate of birth" and
- 29 "certificates of birth" wherever either such term occurs with "birth certificate" and "birth
- 30 certificates", respectively:

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
