A RESOLUTION

1 Adopting the Rules of the Senate for the 2018 Special Session of the General Assembly of

2 Georgia; and for other purposes.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the Rules of the Senate in effect at the
4 adjournment of the 2018 Regular Session of the General Assembly are hereby adopted as the
5 Rules of the Senate for the 2018 Special Session with the following amendments:

SECTION 1.

7 Senate Rule 2-8.3 is amended by revising subsection (b) as follows:

8 "(b) All Committee of Conference reports shall be printed and distributed to the Senators

- 9 on the legislative day prior to consideration of the same during the first thirty-six (36)
- 10 days of any regular session. During the thirty-seventh (37th) through the fortieth (40th)

11 days of any regular session, such reports shall be printed and distributed to the Senators at

12 least two (2) hours prior to consideration of the same; provided that this two (2) hour

13 requirement may be suspended by the affirmative vote of a majority of the members to

SECTION 2.

14 which the Senate is entitled."

16 Senate Rule 2-8.4 is amended by revising it as follows:

17 "2-8.4 Time Limit; Discharge; Appointment of New Members

18 After a Committee of Conference has been in existence for five (5) days twenty-four hours 19 and has failed to make a report to the Senate on the question under consideration, the President of the Senate may discharge the Senate conferees and appoint new conferees, or, 20 21 after forty-eight hours, the Senate, on motion and by a majority vote of all members elected 22 to the Senate, may discharge the Senate conferees and new conferees shall be appointed as provided in Rule 2-8.1, instruct said Senate conferees, or make any other motion not 23 24 contrary to the Rules of the Senate; provided that, during the last five (5) days of the 25 session, the above motions may be made and passed at any time, but not more often than every twenty-four hours." 26

27	SECTION 3.
28	Senate Rule 4-2.6 is amended by revising it as follows:
29	"4-2.6 Order for Second Reading; Second Reading After the 35th Day
30	Any general bill or resolution shall be automatically passed to a second reading Every
31	general bill and resolution shall be read a second time on the same legislative day following
32	the day that the bill or resolution is reported by the committee to which it was referred.
33	Except that after the thirty-fifth (35th) day of any regular session, every bill and resolution
34	shall be read a second time on the same legislative day that the bill or resolution is reported
35	by the committee to which it was referred. No debate shall be admitted upon any bill at the
36	first or second reading."
37	SECTION 4.
38	Senate Rule 4-2.9 is amended by revising subsection (b) as follows:
39	"(b) The Committee on Rules shall arrange and fix the calendar for each day's business for
40	the last thirty-five (35) days of each regular session of the General Assembly and for each
41	day of any 2018 special session of the General Assembly. Such calendar shall be a
42	standing and continuing special order during said period. No matter shall be taken up or
43	acted on otherwise than in the order and manner fixed by such calendar, except by a
44	three-fourths vote of those voting, provided such three-fourths constitutes a majority of the
45	members elected to the Senate. This Rule may not be suspended by a two-thirds vote of
46	the Senate."
47	SECTION 5.
48	Senate Rule 4-2.13 is amended by revising it as follows:
49	"4-2.13 Transmittal to the House
50	No bill or resolution shall be transmitted to the House on the day of passage thereof unless
51	two-thirds of the Senators voting, provided the total vote constitutes a quorum, shall so
52	order. Provided, during the last three legislative days of any regular session and during
53	the 2018 special session, any bill, resolution, or other matter which requires action by the
54	House shall be immediately transmitted to the House by the Secretary of the Senate. The

- Secretary shall also immediately transmit Senate bills and resolutions requiring House
 action on the twenty-eighth (28th) legislative day after any notice to reconsider is disposed
- 57 of."

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SECTION 6.

59 Senate Rule 6-7.1 is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

60 "(c) A notice of motion to reconsider a bill or resolution shall take precedence over a 61 motion to transmit and shall have the effect of defeating the motion to transmit; except on 62 the twenty-eighth (28th) day, and during the last three (3) days of any regular session, and 63 during the 2018 special session, a Senator must give notice immediately of his or her intention to move to reconsider, and the President or the designee of the President shall set 64 a time during the day when the motion will be entertained, so stating the time to the Senate; 65 66 the time shall be at the discretion of the President or the designee of the President, but not 67 less than ten minutes. If the Senate is considering any other business at the time the motion 68 to reconsider has been set to be entertained, the motion will be taken up upon conclusion of that business." 69

70 SECTION 7.

71 Senate Rule 6-7.5 is amended by revising it as follows:

72 *"*6-7.5 Effect of Motion; Return to General Calendar

All bills and resolutions reconsidered shall take their place at the foot of the calendar of

bills then in order for a third reading; however, during the last thirty-five (35) legislative

75 days of each session, a reconsidered bill or resolution which was passed or adopted shall

76 take its place at the foot of the Rules Calendar, and a reconsidered bill or resolution which

77 was defeated shall be placed on the General Calendar."
