A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Georgia Council of Chiropractic and recognizing March 10, 2016, as
2 Chiropractic Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council of Chiropractic was founded in 1982 to promote and
4 protect the identity of chiropractic as a drugless form of health care; and

5 WHEREAS, for over a hundred years, millions of lives have been made better because of
6 chiropractic doctors and their service to the community; and

7 WHEREAS, the leaders of the chiropractic profession, under the vision and direction of Dr.
8 Sid Williams, recognized the need for an organization to ensure that Georgia citizens could
9 continue to receive such care; and

10 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council of Chiropractic is fully committed to protecting,
11 promoting, and perpetuating chiropractic to benefit Georgia's citizens and the chiropractors
12 serving in Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, the organization believes that detecting and correcting vertebral subluxations
14 is a just and noble cause, allowing people to express their innate potential for health,
15 happiness, and overall well-being; and

16 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council of Chiropractic notes that chiropractic should remain a
17 nontherapeutic profession that does not include the use of drugs or surgery; and

18 WHEREAS, the organization, under the leadership of its current president, Dr. Awais Butt,
19 has hundreds of doctor members that serve thousands of Georgia citizens and is committed
20 to producing leaders in the health care profession who can offer citizens a healthier and
21 happier life; and

22 WHEREAS, by offering chiropractors over 120 hours of continuing education through
23 seminars, the Georgia Council of Chiropractic brings doctors from all over the world with
24 the most current information to help serve patients to the best of their ability; and

25 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the Georgia Council of Chiropractic be
26 appropriately recognized.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 commend the Georgia Council of Chiropractic for its dedicated service to the State of
29 Georgia and recognize March 10, 2016, as Chiropractic Day at the capitol.
