A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Vincent Michael Rossetti, and expressing regret at his
2 passing; and for other purposes.

21 many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he

22 possessed the vast wisdom which comes only through experience and the strength of
23 character which is achieved through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Rossetti had a reputation for integrity, hard work, and kindness, and by the
25 example he has made of his life, he makes this world a better place in which to live; and it
26 is only fitting and proper that this caring man who has contributed so much be recognized
27 after this tragic occasion; and

29 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
