A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Charles and Deborah Tillman; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the town of Tison was a center of commerce during the later part of the 19th
- 3 Century through the 1940s, with the Padgett family at the center, and Tison Crossroads, at
- 4 the intersection of Georgia Highway 169 and County Road 293, consisted of the Padgett
- 5 home place, two commissary stores with post offices, a barrel-making business, lumber mill,
- 6 turpentine business, and grist mill; and
- 7 WHEREAS, in 1820 three members of the Padgett family settled on the banks of
- 8 Watermelon Creek Vineyard and began to forge a legacy that influenced agriculture,
- 9 business, and spiritual life in Tattnall County; and
- 10 WHEREAS, in 2003 Charles Tillman, an 8th generation descendant from the original Padgett
- 11 family, and his wife, Deborah, purchased the Padgett home place and adjacent acreage to
- 12 include the late 19th Century barns, commissary store, and additional outbuildings and
- 13 embarked on their restoration; they have plans to acquire the second commissary store and
- are in the application process to receive a National Historic Registry designation for the area
- which contains the original two stores, home place, and adjacent barnyard and outbuildings;

- 17 WHEREAS, plans for the restoration will incorporate commercial enterprises in addition to
- 18 the expansion of the current Farm Tour that is offered by Watermelon Creek Vineyard, the
- 19 full service Georgia Farm Winery that Charles and Deborah opened in May of 2012 on the
- 20 banks of Watermelon Creek. The winery is a silver member of Georgia Grown and has
- 21 Georgia Agritourism signage on Highway 301 and 23/57 in Glennville.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 23 commend Charles and Deborah Tillman on their efforts to preserve the history of Tison
- 24 Crossroads in Tattnall County.
