A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Connor Roberts, Stephens County School System's 2014 STAR Student; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

5 WHEREAS, Connor Roberts has shown by academic accomplishment that the pursuit and
6 attainment of scholastic success are within the reach of the students in this state; and

7 WHEREAS, Connor is the son of Barry and Lynn Roberts of Toccoa; and

8 WHEREAS, a gifted student at Stephens County High School, this remarkable scholar has
9 been recognized for superlative achievement and selected as Stephens County School
10 System's 2014 STAR Student; and

11 WHEREAS, to be selected as a STAR Student for a high school, a student must have
12 obtained the highest score in one administration of the three-part Scholastic Aptitude Test
13 and be in the top 10 percent or top ten students of his or her class; and

14 WHEREAS, Connor scored 2380 out of a possible 2400 on the Scholastic Aptitude Test and
15 was recently accepted for admission into Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts;

17 WHEREAS, each school has one STAR Student who in turn has the opportunity to choose
18 a STAR Teacher who has been inspiring and encouraging throughout that student's high
19 school career; and

20 WHEREAS, educator Tamera Cash was chosen by Connor as Stephens County School
21 System's 2014 STAR Teacher for the great support and guidance provided to him throughout
22 the years; and

23 WHEREAS, Connor has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
24 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

25 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
26 bright and promising young citizen.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
28 commend Connor Roberts for being named Stephens County School System's 2014 STAR
29 Student and express their most sincere best wishes for continued academic success.
