A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Auburn University senior and Haralson County High School graduate Blake Poole;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Blake Poole is the first Haralson County High School graduate to play in a BCS
4 National Championship Game and is now a senior at Auburn University, where he has
5 proved himself to be outstanding as both a scholar in Agricultural Leadership and a member
6 of the Auburn football team; and

7 WHEREAS, in 2009, he was a walk-on player at Auburn University, where after three years
8 he earned a full scholarship and played three seasons. During his attendance at Auburn, he
9 participated in the Outback Bowl, the SEC Championship, and the National Championship;

11 WHEREAS, as a student athlete, Blake was able to focus on his academics as well as
12 football, allowing him to graduate in four years with majors in Agricultural Leadership and
13 Political Science. He is a member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes and serves as Vice
14 President of Auburn University's Block and Bridle Club; and

15 WHEREAS, he has been awarded the prestigious title of "Mr. College of Agriculture" for
16 2013, based upon his dedication, positive attitude, and genial personality; and

17 WHEREAS, it is altogether fitting and proper that he be recognized by this body.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend Blake Poole for his many outstanding achievements and exemplary life.
