A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Thelma Pinckney Scott; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Mrs. Thelma Pinckney Scott on January 28, 2014; and

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Scott was born on March 15, 1922, in Hampton County, South Carolina,
5 a beloved daughter of the late Richard and Amanda Pinckney; and

6 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Scott was baptized at an early age and
7 was an active member of St. Luke Baptist Church choir and the March Birth Month Club;

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Scott was married to the late Mr. Henry Bing and later married Mr. Albert
10 Scott and was blessed with five remarkable children, Daisy, Barbara, Rachel, Albert, and Eli,
11 and ten grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren; and

13 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
14 her family and friends were admired by others; and

15 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation

18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Mrs. Scott will long be remembered for
19 her love of family and friendship, and this loyal mother, grandmother, and friend will be
20 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.
