## ADOPTED SENATE

## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Senate Study Committee on Local Government Fees; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, many people argue that the persons creating the costs of providing services by
- 3 local governments should bear the costs of such services, while others argue that such
- 4 services are a part of government which all of the taxpayers should fund; and
- 5 WHEREAS, this philosophy of having the people who create the need for services fund such
- 6 services has led to the development of numerous fees at the local government level; and
- 7 WHEREAS, some notable examples of such fees are storm-water management fees, which
- 8 are assessed on a property based on the area of impervious surfaces located on the property;
- 9 fire service fees, which are imposed on all buildings in a jurisdiction; and the many add-on
- 10 fees imposed for traffic violations and other court cases for various purposes; and
- 11 WHEREAS, some have questioned whether these fees are fairly and equitably imposed and
- whether the revenue generated by such fees is being appropriately used and directed for the
- 13 purposes for which it is intended; and
- 14 WHEREAS, a study of such fees is needed to ensure that this method of financing local
- 15 government services is fair and equitable and is being properly used by local governments
- 16 in Georgia.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:
- 18 (1) **Creation of Senate study committee.** There is created the Senate Study Committee
- on Local Government Fees.
- 20 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- 21 Senate to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor. The Lieutenant Governor shall
- designate a member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.

23 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,

- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 26 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 27 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

## 30 (5) Allowances and funding.

- 31 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 33 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the Senate.

- 38 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 42 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 45 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- 47 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 48 the Secretary of the Senate.
- 49 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Secretary
- of the Senate a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 51 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2018.
