A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Dr. Marvin Crumbs; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
3 important objective of the General Assembly; and

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Marvin Crumbs, the principal of Columbus High School, has long been
5 recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital role he has played in the teaching
6 profession and his deep personal commitment to the education of the students of Georgia;

8 WHEREAS, he was selected for a national conference to discuss how to help children from
9 low-income families become high-achieving students; and

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Crumbs was among more than 100 principals from around the country who
11 attended the Closing the Excellence Gap Summit on February 25-26 in Washington, D.C.,
12 which was sponsored by the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation and the Coalition of Leaders for
13 Advanced Student Success; and

14 WHEREAS, he credits all of Columbus High School's stakeholders for the school's success,
15 and he attributes his success as a principal to the dedicated teachers, hard-working students,
16 supportive parents, and a school district that realizes every child matters; and

17 WHEREAS, in recognition of his contributions to the education and welfare of young people
18 in this state, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
19 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 recognize and commend Dr. Marvin Crumbs for his dedicated public service to the State of
22 Georgia and express sincere best wishes for continued success.
