A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Lumpkin County as the Wine Tasting Room Capital of Georgia; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the spirit of teamwork and regionalism creates a synergy of economic
- 4 development through culinary and agricultural tourism; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Lumpkin County is positioned to claim this identity because no region in
- 6 Georgia has 11 wine tasting rooms, offering the variety and quality of vintner arts; and
- 7 WHEREAS, today they have tremendous opportunities to share award-winning, local,
- 8 regional, and international wines with locals and visitors through their local wineries, wine
- 9 tasting rooms in Lumpkin County and Downtown Dahlonega, and Tasting Room touring
- 10 packages and events, such as the Dahlonega Wine Trail Event and the Downtown Dahlonega
- 11 Wine Walk; and
- 12 WHEREAS, their locally owned and operated wineries and tasting rooms take immense
- pride in sharing their wines with hospitality, knowledge, and enthusiasm and are committed
- 14 to representing Dahlonega-Lumpkin County as the "Heart of Georgia's Wine Country,"
- 15 making Lumpkin County a vintner and culinary destination and the perfect candidate for
- 16 designation as the "Wine Tasting Room Capital of Georgia"; and
- 17 WHEREAS, agri-tourism and vintner and culinary tourism make three of the largest
- 18 economic contributions to the county, city, and communities in Lumpkin County; and
- 19 WHEREAS, there are five wineries in Lumpkin County; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Lumpkin County boasts the highest concentration of wineries and vineyards in
- 21 Georgia, producing European, French Hybrid, and American wine-grapes; and

WHEREAS, the Lumpkin County wineries annually produce 100 acres of grapes, yielding

- 23 23,000 bottled cases, and attract more than 100,000 wine enthusiasts.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 25 recognize Lumpkin County as the Wine Tasting Room Capital of Georgia.
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 27 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the wineries of
- 28 Lumpkin County.
