## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 6, 2017, as Math Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council of Teachers of Mathematics is an affiliate of the National  
3 Council of Teachers of Mathematics and is composed of classroom teachers from preschool  
4 to graduate school, as well as nonteaching individuals, who share an interest in mathematics  
5 education in Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the mission of the Council is to promote a high quality mathematics education  
7 for all students, encourage an active interest in mathematics and mathematics education,  
8 promote ongoing professional development for mathematics education, and reward  
9 excellence in the teaching of mathematics in this state; and
- 10 WHEREAS, one of the fundamental objectives of the Council is to act as an advocate for the  
11 improvement of mathematics education at all levels in Georgia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, as part of this mission, the Georgia Council of Teachers of Mathematics hopes  
13 that Math Day at the capitol will promote the importance of mathematics education in this  
14 state and highlight the connection between mathematically literate citizens and economic  
15 development.
- 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 recognize February 6, 2017, as Math Day at the capitol.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
19 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia  
20 Council of Teachers of Mathematics.
