- 11 WHEREAS, he was the owner and operator of Robertson Paving and Grading, the owner of
12 Augusta Asphalt, LLC, and a part-owner of Washington Wilkes Stockyard; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Robertson was known for his love of the outdoors and raising cattle; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
15 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
16 made this world a better place in which to live.
