- 16 of the Georgia State AFL-CIO; and
- WHEREAS, during his outstanding career, he worked directly on and supervised the workers
- 18 that built the beautiful Atlanta skyline, including the Omni, the Atlanta Federal Reserve, and
- 19 the Atlanta International Airport; and
- 20 WHEREAS, his dedication to public service allowed him to work with Bayard Rustin,
- 21 Maynard Jackson, Herb Mabry, Howard Henson, Sr., and a host of local and national
