## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the men and women of the United States Armed Forces from the Greater  
2 Augusta region; and for other purposes.

5 sacrifice, and service; and

6 WHEREAS, the Greater Augusta region is home to countless active-duty service members,  
7 veterans, reservists, and National Guard personnel who have honorably served and continue

9 WHEREAS, Fort Eisenhower (formerly Fort Gordon) and other military installations in the  
10 region have played a critical role in national defense, providing strategic support, training,  
11 and resources to ensure the readiness of our Armed Forces; and

13 unwavering support and resilience as their loved ones answer the call of duty; and

17 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that we, as a community, express our profound gratitude  
18 and appreciation for the selfless service, dedication, and valor exhibited by these  
19 extraordinary men and women.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 commend the men and women of the United States Armed Forces from the Greater Augusta  
22 region for their exemplary contributions to the security, prosperity, and well-being of our  
23 great nation.
