4 WHEREAS, Mr. Bernard F. Miles was recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital  
5 role he played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens  
6 of Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Miles diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,  
8 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced  
9 dramatically by his superlative service with the Richmond County Board of Education and  
10 as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives; and

11 WHEREAS, he began his career with Feedwright Milling Company, opened a local grocery  
12 store in Augusta, and founded the Richmond County newspaper; and

13 WHEREAS, a successful entrepreneur and businessman, Mr. Miles was also the owner of  
14 Fleming Tractor and Equipment Corporation and Fleming Fuel Oil Company; and

15 WHEREAS, he was an early advocate and board member for Teen Town, helped start the  
16 Fleming Community Center, and was a member of the board of directors for Richmond  
17 County Bank; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
19 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his honor.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ENACTED that the portion of Highway 25 between  
22 Lumpkin Road and I-520 in Richmond County is dedicated as the Bernard F. Miles  
23 Memorial Highway.
