A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the Atlanta Braves; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021, the Atlanta Braves clinched their first World Series title
3 since 1995 after shutting out the Houston Astros 7-0 in Game 6; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Braves have won four World Series titles (two as the Atlanta
5 Braves) and 19 National League pennants; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Braves care about their social responsibility and community, the
7 promotion of health and wellness, investing in education, supporting the growth and
8 development of youth baseball and softball, and honoring and encouraging community
9 service; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Atlanta Braves have created a partnership with the Georgia Council on
11 American Indian Concerns and other tribal leaders to collaborate on matters related to
12 culture, history, education, outreach, and recognition; and
- 13 WHEREAS, to expand Native American education, the Braves have worked to produce both
14 internal and external educational programs and to introduce a Georgia Native American

15 history curriculum into the state's school systems, primarily for students in the eighth grade;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, on October 4, 2021, the Georgia Council on American Indian Concerns adopted
18 a resolution honoring and expressing appreciation to the Atlanta Braves.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 honor the Atlanta Braves for their World Series Championship, for the excellence of the
21 Atlanta Braves' organization, for appreciating their millions of fans, and for their partnership
22 with Georgia's Native American community.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
24 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
25 press.
