## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of William G. Fallin; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of William G. Fallin on January 4, 2025; and
- 4 WHEREAS, William G. Fallin was born on September 9, 1932, in Thomas County, Georgia,  
5 a beloved son of Brady and Ernestine Fallin; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
7 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the Korean  
8 War; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, William G. Fallin was an active member of  
10 First Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon, Sunday School Teacher, choir member,  
11 and co-chair of two renovation projects; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife of 67 years, Barbara, and was  
13 blessed with three children, Leah, Laura, and William; six wonderful grandchildren, Ernest,

14 Stuart, Katherine, Thomas, Robert, and William; and two treasured great-granddaughters,  
15 Mary and Fallin; and

16 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
17 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
18 family and friends were admired by others; and

19 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
20 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
21 made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, William G. Fallin will long be remembered  
23 for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great  
24 fortune of knowing him.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
26 join in honoring the life and memory of William G. Fallin and express their deepest and most  
27 sincere regret at his passing.
