A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Macy McFall; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Macy McFall worked from 2021 to 2022 as the first female chief of staff for
3 a lieutenant governor in Georgia, serving as Lieutenant Governor Geoff Duncan's designee
4 on the General Assembly's Litigation Oversight Committee as well as the top strategist for
5 public policy decisions and legislative initiatives; and

6 WHEREAS, her performance as chief of staff is backed by eight years of experience working
7 in state politics, including roles such as legislative assistant, senate aide, director of
8 operations in the office of Lieutenant Governor Casey Cagle, and more; and

9 WHEREAS, while obtaining her law degree from Georgia State University College of Law,
10 Macy also served in the Senate Research Office as a legislative policy analyst, advising
11 legislators on ethics and elections policy as well as state and local regulatory issues; and

12 WHEREAS, Macy's significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience
13 and diplomacy, and exceptional ability to engender consensus on difficult issues have earned
14 her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

15 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
16 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

17 WHEREAS, Macy has served the Georgia Senate with honor and distinction, and her tireless
18 dedication and unyielding commitment to excellence have set the standard for exemplary
19 service; and

20 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
21 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend Macy McFall on her outstanding career and wish her the best in all
24 of her future endeavors.
