A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Herbert Greene for the great contributions he has made to Columbus State
2 University men's basketball and athletics; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Columbus State University named the court at Lumpkin Center to honor former
4 coach Herbert Greene for the indelible mark he left on CSU athletics; and

5 WHEREAS, his career as a coach and athletic director spans 42 years, 28 of which were
6 spent at Columbus College (now Columbus State); and

7 WHEREAS, he holds a 481-240 record in 25 seasons at CSU, four regular season Peach Belt
8 Conference titles, six Peach Belt tournament titles, a 29-9 tournament record, 16 seasons with
9 19 or more wins, nine NCAA tournament appearances, and two Sweet 16 appearances; and

10 WHEREAS, he spent most of his time at CSU in the dual roles of men's basketball coach and
11 athletic director; and

12 WHEREAS, under his leadership, the Cougars won 48 conference championships and five
13 national titles.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 commend Herbert Greene for the great contribution he has made to Columbus State
16 University men's basketball and athletics.
