A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Nicholas Stoll; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Nicholas Stoll has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
3 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Nicholas has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special
9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 580 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project, Nicholas led a team of scouts,
14 JROTC cadets, and other volunteers in replacing 60 railroad ties used in the landscaping of
15 the church parking lot at Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church in Lilburn, Georgia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Nicholas has truly exhibited a commitment to the
17 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
18 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
20 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend Nicholas Stoll for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor
23 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious
24 rank of Eagle Scout.
