A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Screven County Development Authority on the 50th
2 anniversary of the signing of the legislation that created the development authority; and for
3 other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Screven County Development Authority was created by a House Resolution
5 during the 1962 session of the Georgia General Assembly and the legislation was signed in
6 1963; and

7 WHEREAS, the Screven County Development Authority was created to develop, promote,
8 and expand industry, agriculture, commerce, natural resources, and vocational training for the
9 public good and general welfare and to make long-range plans to coordinate such
10 development, promotion, and expansion within its territorial limits; and

11 WHEREAS, the Screven County Development Authority consists of Executive Director Dorie
12 Bacon and a seven-member board, including Chairman Bobby Smith, Jr., Vice Chairman
13 David Boddiford, Secretary and Treasurer Ricky McGhee, Todd Bazemore, John Mark
14 Counts, Stephen Milner, and Davy Wells; and

15 WHEREAS, the citizens who have served on the board have worked tirelessly on many tasks,
16 including the recruitment and retention of the county's two largest employers, Koyo Bearings
17 and King America Finishing, and the acquisition and development of the existing Screven
18 County Industrial Park; and

19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments and the
20 50th anniversary of the Screven County Development Authority be appropriately recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 commend the Screven County Development Authority for their contributions to the citizens

23 of Screven County, congratulate the authority on its 50th anniversary, and extend to them
24 their best wishes for future success.
