

Senate Resolution 420

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Georgia so as to provide that this
 2 state shall recognize the paramount right to life of all human beings as persons at any stage
 3 of development; to provide for submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection;
 4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article I, Section I of the Constitution is amended by redesignating Paragraph XXIX as
 8 Paragraph XXX and inserting a new Paragraph XXIX to read as follows:

9 "Paragraph XXIX. *Paramount right to life.* This state shall recognize the paramount right
 10 to life of all human beings as persons at any stage of development."

12 SECTION 2.

13 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
 14 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
 15 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

16 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that this state
 17 shall recognize the paramount right to life of all human beings as persons
 18 () NO at any stage of development?"

19 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

20 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
 21 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
 22 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
