- 4 Commissioner, providing both exceptional leadership and powerful advocacy for the needs

- 13 served in this capacity ever since; and
- 14 WHEREAS, during his tenure, Commissioner Holder worked tirelessly on behalf of his
- 15 constituents to improve the quality of life in District I, seeing the acquisition of Locust Grove
- 16 Event Center to be utilized by area senior citizens and the community as a whole, the
- 17 construction of a new Locust Grove Public Library, various improvements to parks and
- 18 recreation facilities and the completion of many road and transportation projects necessary
- 19 for the growing county, as well as clarifying the boundary line between Butts and Henry
- 20 counties in order to improve public safety; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Commissioner Holder was also able to help secure three successful SPLOST
- 22 programs providing funding for numerous capital and roads projects to ease the burden on
